The department of Medical-Surgical Nursing hosted International Conference on 21/02/2022 under the theme of "Just Culture and Patient Safety Goals".

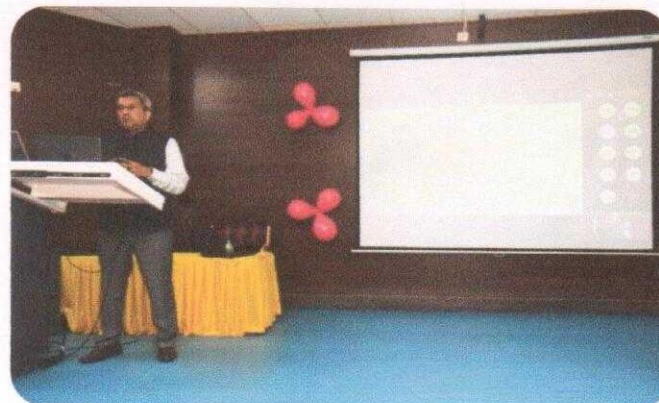
**The Conference aimed to:**

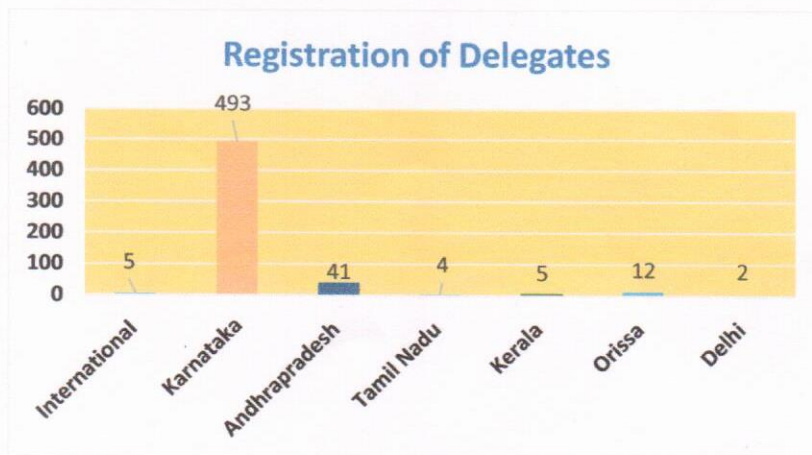

The session speaker's feedback was analyzed and revealed that more than 85% of the delegates expressed that, conference was very useful & suggested on the following topics for future Conferences:


- Quality of health care professionals to improve patient safety,
