



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

The presentation started at 10am. Presentation was led by Ms. Anisha Maria benny, program started with Invocation song by Ms. Alka and Ms. Nivya kumar




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Group 2 Presented experiential learning method on Normal pregnancy and Physiological changes during pregnancy.



One example was Mrs. Soumya, 30 years old, Antenatal mother (G₁P₂L₂A₆Sb₀) multigravida with cephalic presentation came for safe confinement. Student presented her experience in witnessing the labour and shared the management protocol maintained during the delivery. Starting from induction to shifting the mother to postnatal ward, the student shared her experience. Followed by four students shared their experience about breech delivery, forceps delivery and vacuum delivery.




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Group presented on integrated learning method on Partograph and NST, interpretation of values.



In detail lecture was taken on partograph and NST, Students compared old partograph with new WHO Partograph and explained on the changes that was updated. Maintenance of partograph in labor room cases was presented including NST.



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Group 4 presented on experiential learning on placenta removal and its examination.



Student presented on third stage of management and drugs given after placenta delivery. Further examination of placenta was done at class explaining on maternal and fetal surfaces and umbilical cord.



Case was on multigravida mother Mrs. Meena 27years old with obstetrical score $G_5P_3L_1A_1D_2Sb_0$ delivered vaginally a single live female baby and placenta was removed by controlled cord traction method.

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Group presented on Evidence-based Learning method on eclampsia.

Student presented on A 26 years old primigravida mother, Mrs. Nisha with 30 weeks 4 days of gestation with complaints of headache, blurring of vision and an episode of convulsion. Student presented on management of Eclampsia. And students presented on four cases with the similar condition and presented on research findings on eclampsia case. Student also conducted simulation on eclampsia management.





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Group Presented on Teenage pregnancy by learning in

humanitiesmethod. The case presented wasCase presented was on Ms. Shahiya 17yrs old unmarried girl with 10weeks 3days came to hospital with unknown drug consumption to abort. They enacted the causes of teenage pregnancy and unwed mothers causes, its effects in society.

They explained on the causes, diagnosis and management of IUD case.
