HISTORY OF DIMHANS

• Institute was started as a "Lunatic asylum" in 1845 in the premises attached to a jail. Later in 1885 some rooms of the jail were used as wards for keeping patients. In year 1909, asylum was separated from the jail and a wall around asylum was constructed. In year 1922, British Government declared asylum as "Government Mental Hospital". In 1993, with intention to reduce stigma, name of the hospital was changed from "Government Mental Hospital" to "Karnataka Institute of Mental Health" (KIMH). Based on the recommendations of the D. M. Nanjundappa report on correction of regional disparities in Karnataka, the institute was converted into an autonomous post-graduation training institute and renamed as Dharwad institute of Mental Health and Neurosciences (DIMHANS) during a legislative assembly session in 2009.

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VISION MISSION AND MANDATE

* To develop institute into a centre of Excellence for creating man power to meet mental health needs of the people of North Karnataka. The Institute on priority basis already started post- graduation courses in psychiatry, clinical psychology, psychiatric social work and psychiatric nursing. Development of community mental health services is the top most priority of the institute. In this regard training programmes for medical officers and health workers at various levels of community health will be taken up. Institutes emphasis is on development of school mental health programme, community based Deaddiction and women mental health services. Specialized training courses in Forensic Psychiatry will planned in future considering large number of patients getting admitted in Forensic wards



In DIMHANS De-addiction discharge procedure will be done increase of complete recovery or if the family members are interest to take home to the patient but it is done on the basis of the psychiatrist order. The amount should be cleared at the time of discharge.



REPORT OF DAY CARE AND PSYCHIATRIC REHABILITATION CENTRE SERVICE

DIMHANS day care & psychiatric rehabilitation centre is location "bendre block" which was inaugurated in November 2020. Day care & rehabilitation services was established to help person with chronic and disabling mental disorders to return to an optimum level of functioning and to achieving their life goals. The team working in day care and rehabilitation centre consists of:

- Psychiatrists
- Psychiatric social workers
- Clinical psychologist
- Psychiatric nursing
- As well as skilled vocational trainers

Dr.Manjunath.B is the head of the unit. The team not only promote recovery, but go beyond the alleviation of symptoms of psychiatric disorders and help the disabled individuals to develop the emotional, social & intellectual skills needed to live learn

& Work in the community with the least amount of professional support

The interventions are tailored for each individual and attempts to integrate the patients with main stream society and improve quality of life for both the persons with psychiatric disorder

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and their families. The centre provides rehabilitation services in various setting. Patients attending OPD services, who are in need of rehabilitation can attend the day care for vocational and skills training. In patient needed activity scheduling or vocational & skills training are sent to the rehabilitation centre at prescribed hours

A range of vocational sections, art and recreation facilities are available for client attending day care, vocational training course such as tailoring, baking, handicraft, mat making etc. are available. Patient also engaged in recreational activities, physical exercise and yoga.

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

FEMALE ACUTE WARD REPORT

Female acute ward of DIMHANS is located near the library in the ground floor. It is in the male and female acute ward block. It consists of three units they are namely A, B and C units. Each units have an office, washing area, nurses' station and toilet. There are 20 beds in each ward. The windows and three doors, balcony and corridors are provided for the patient. Patient can spend their leisure time in this corridor.

The total number of admissions in A unit is 20 and discharge is 10. In B and C unit there are 20 admissions and 8 discharge. This units are guided by HOD and staff nurses. Patient and faculties obey all the rules and regulations of the female ward, so that the ward is perfectly

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE WARD

- 1. Keep ward environment calm and quiet.
- 2. Only one attender is allowed with each patient
- 3. Smoking, use of tobacco, alcohol, other substances are prohibited in the ward.
- 4. Do not dump waste materials in the ward,
- 5. Necessary things to be kept in locker neatly.
- 6. Hospital staff and management is not responsible for belongings of the patient.
- Patient should participate in the ward activities.
- 8. Do not keep dangerous object near the patient such as knife, blades, scissors, belt, tie, match box etc.
- Help patient in taking bath, food, medication etc.
- 10. Monitor patient behaviour closely.
- 11. Do not leave the patient alone.
- 12. Maintain silence in the ward
- 13. Recognize abnormal behaviour of your patient and intimate concerned nurse immediately.
- 14. Do not discuss any traumatic news Infront of the patient.

The most common cases that are seen in the female ward is Schizophrenia, Psychosis, Depression, Bipolar Affective Disorder (BPAD) Epilepsy, and Mania.

There is long activity space Infront of the ward were patient do recreational activities. Recreational activities are headed by students and staff nurses. The recreational activities include exercises, yoga, singing etc... Each ward has time schedule displayed in which the timings for daily routine activities. The time schedule is

AVERAGE PATIENTS PER MONTH

Everyday 300 to 400 patients come to DIMHANS for OPD. Tuesday and Friday 100to 15 patients come to DIMHANS for neurologic basic purpose. An average patient per month visited in DIMHANS is around 9000-12000 per month.

SPECIALITY CLINICS

There is a separate neurology clinic running on Tuesday Friday from 9am to 4pm.

TIMINGS

OPD The OPD services are available 6days a week from Monday to Saturday with registration timings from 9am to 4pm. The remains closed on the 3 national holiday (Independence Day, republic day, Gandhi Jayanti)



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REGISTRATION

The registration process for the OPD is available from 9am to 3:30pm on working days in designated registration counter at the OPD. Registration is mandatory on every visits for any consultation at the OPD. There is separate registration desk in the counter.

COMMON PHYCHIATRIC CONDITION OBSERVED IN OPD

Everyday DIMHANS provide consultant facilities for a large varities of disease condition. Some of them are:

- 1. Schizophrenia
- 2. Psychosis
- 3. Alcohol dependency syndrome
- 4. Mania
- 5. Depression
- 6. Bipolar affective disorder

LEARNING EXPERIENCE FROM OPD

From the 15 days of psychiatric postings in OPD we the students got information regarding the various services provided in OPD, we got a chance to get exposure to the various disease conditions that came for consultant in OPD. The students in the OPD posting started their duty by checking the vitals and collected a brief history from the patient side. Also, the posting help the students to maintain interpersonal relationship the patient.

CONCLUSION

The DIMHANS institute was established in 1845 by the British government. It is a public medical institution in Dharwad, Karnataka which provide health care facilities specializing in mental health, psychiatry and neuroscience

The average daily outpatient came for consultant in DIMHANS is around 300 to 400.

Besides from this DIMHANS provide services patient with neurological cases on Tuesday and Friday

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By the end of 15 days posting, we earned some knowledge regarding wide variety of disease condition which is daily consulting in OPD and also about the layout or physical structure of OPD in DIMHANS

MALE ACUTE WARD

Male acute ward is located at the topmost floor in the Male and Female acute ward block, near to the male chronic ward.

It consists of 3 units. These are: -

4 A unit

4 B&C unit

4 Cunit

The treatment team consists of Psychiatrist, Senior Resident, Junior Resident, Psychiatric Social Worker, Clinical psychologist and Psychiatric Nursing staff including ward sisters and staff nurses. The ward provides regular patient care services including medication and check-up, hygienic and nutritious diet, laundered clothes, recreation facilities and other basic amenities.

Each unit has an office, nurses' station, washing area and a toilet in it. Each unit has 20 number of beds in total, 22 ventilation, 22 windows and 3 doors in it. Two doors are present at the entrance while another door leads to the corridor or balcony, where patients can spend their free time. The indoor has provision of visiting room for the guardians and relatives to meet their wards. Counselling services are provided to the guardians during their visits and at the time of discharge of the patient. Hygienic food is served to the patients. Calorie intake ranges from 2500 to 3000 for each patient. All the admitted patients are provided with a modern hospital bed, mattress and laundered dresses. Salon services are also made available.

The total number of admissions in a month in A unit is 19 admissions and discharge are 10 discharges in the month of June. In B & C unit, there was 52 admissions and 37 discharges in the month of June. In C unit, there was 27 admissions and 14 discharges in the month of June.

Various rules and regulations in the ward are:

- Keep ward environment calm and quiet.
- Only one attender is allowed with each patient.
- Smoking, using tobacco and other substance are prohibited in the ward.
- Do not dumb waste material in the ward.
- Necessary things to be kept in locker neatly.
- Help patient in taking bath, food, medication etc.
- Monitor patient behavior closely.
- Hospital, staffs and management is not responsible for their belongings.

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
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The most commonly seen cases in male acute ward is schizophrenia, psychosis, depression, OCD, epilepsy, ATPD, BPAD, alcohol dependence syndrome and mania.

In front of the male acute ward, there is a space where recreational activities are conducted for the patients. Patients regularly gather to read newspapers, magazines and books, enjoy musicand television programs. Outdoor games include volleyball and football. During morning and evening hours the patients undergo P.T exercise and yoga, During the celebration of festivals both patients and staff participate in games conducted followed by prize distribution ceremony.

Each ward has time schedule displayed in which the timings for daily routine activities are present.

MALE AND FEMALE FORENSIC WARD

As per our mental health clinical posting in DIMHANS for 15days (15/06/2022 to 30/06/2022). The male forensic ward is situated nearby the rehabilitation centre and the female forensic ward is located in the ground floor nearby the female acute ward.

MALE FORENSIC WARD

The male forensic ward is a strictly restricted area which consists of high risk patients who have criminal background. It is under controlled by the higher authorities of DIMHANS. The ward consists of 4 units, each unit has washing area and toilets separately. The nursing station is placed at the centre of the ward which is seen from the entrance area. There are 10 beds in each unit. The wards are accurately ventilated with 15 windows and 5 doors including the main entrance door. This units are guided by HOD and staff nurses and guarded by securities and police officers. The male forensic ward consists of patients with" schizophrenia, psychosis, mania, depression, and bipolar affective disorder (BPAD). The patients can cooperate with the ward atmosphere and the ward is fully occupied with all necessary equipment and medications.

FEMALE FORENSIC WARD

The female forensic ward is a separated section. The older orphan and mentally retarded female patients are placed in the ward with diagnosis such as "psychosis, mania, schizophrenia, depression." The bed capacity of the ward is 24 beds. The ward consists of 22 windows and 3 doors, 4 toilets and bathrooms. The nursing station is situated in right side of the entrance area. There is a corridor which the recreational activities such as meditations and yoga, exercises were taken place. These activities are headed by the students and staff nurses. The patients are co-operated with ward atmosphere and ward is equipped with all necessary medications.





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ELECTRO CONVULSIVE THERAPY ROOM

On 15/6/2022 onwards we were oriented to DIMHANS. On 16/6/2022 onwards various group were started to exposure to ECT department.

ECT department is located at the ground floor of the administration block. ECT is scheduled from 9.00am to 11.30am on Monday, Wednesday and Friday. 5 patients will undergo ECT on each day. The duration of each session is 10 to 20 minutes. ECT therapy is mainly given for major depression, severe catatonia, severe psychosis and organic mental disorders.

PSYCHOEDUCATION CENTRE

Psychoeducation centre is located at the topmost floor in the administration block, near to the academic block. Psychoeducation centre id divided into 2 sections. There are psychosocial services and psychological services.

Psychosocial services include

- 1. Family Therapy
- 2. Group Therapy
- 3. Community mental health services.

Psychological services include

- 1. Child and adolescent therapy
- Family therapy
- 3. Assessment therapy 1 and 2
- 4. Behavioural therapy

The aim of this unit is to target individuals with psychological and social problems. The clients can directly visit the unit for consultation. The unit also receives referrals from the patients visiting the out-patient departments. The services offered are counselling psychotherapy and psychodiagnostics such as neuropsychological test lab, psychological test lab. The major diagnosis commonly assessed and managed at the unit include childhood depression, learning problems, autism intellectual disability, suicide, dementia, anxiety disorders, epilepsy, headache, headache, family problems, substances use disorders, sexual disorders and many more. The unit also has to special clinic dedicated to obsessive compulsive disorder every Wednesday and suicide prevention every Saturday.

Therapy is scheduled from 9 am to 4 pm, from Monday to Saturday. The duration of each session is 45 min. Behavioural therapy and motivation therapy mainly given for ADS patients. Cognitive behavioural therapy is given for autism, and for childrens with disabilities and parenteral management is given for parents who are having disabled children. Other therapies given in the hospital are




