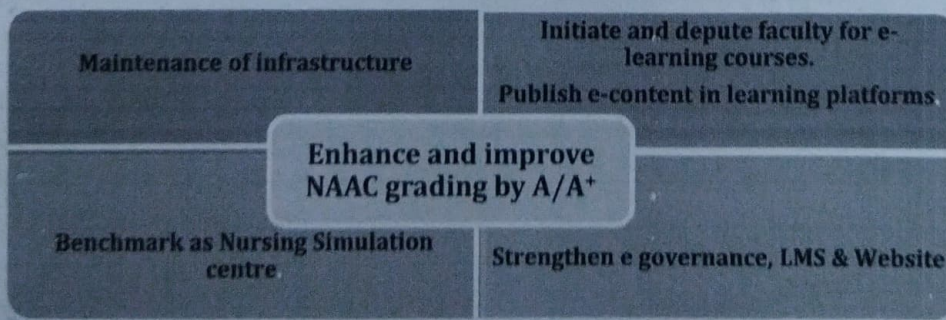
Outcome: -After the amendment & permission a total of five students have enrolled for P.B. BSc & Nine students for M. Sc(N) Degree.




The members suggested compare our performance with institutions who have secured A/A+ NAAC-Grade by benchmarking and comparing the implementation strategies.

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
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
