## REPORT OF ANTENATAL CLINIC - 2023

We the 4th year BSc nursing PHC group students from department of Community Health Nursing of Sri Devaraj Urs College of Nursing organized Antenatal clinic on 09-02-2023 at 10:30 am for antenatal smothers in Devarayasamudra PHC under the guidance of Mrs Vani. R (Assistant professor, department of CHN) and Mrs Komala (Tutor of CHN department).

The program started at 10:30 am with invocation song by ms. Annie and team, IV-year bsc nursing. In charge students were allotted to different sections. The first counter started by registration section, a total of 17 mothers had been registered in the clinic, in the registration section the mothers were provided with antenatal card (annexure-1) and demographic data was collected (annexure-2).

In the second counter the vitals parameters of the mothers recorded in the antenatal card. The Hemoglobulin level of the mothers checked in the counter three. The fourth counter was abdominal/antenatal examination, assessments like examination of fundal height, foetal movement etc, were carried out. Each mother was accompanied by a student to various section of the clinic from registration till the assessment section. After the assessment section antenatal mothers were made assembled together for group health education on the topic antenatal diet (annexure-3) and antenatal exercise. In order to make aware diet and health live demonstration of sample menu plan as per the recommended calorie requirement of the antenatal mother was demonstrate and discussed. By12:30 pm we ended up the antenatal clinic, and refreshments were given to the antenatal mothers.
